Taxpayer Eligibility Checklist

Is your adjusted gross income (AGI) **less than or equal to \$89,000**? (See attached sheet if you need to estimate your AGI)

Yes – you are eligible for Facilitated Self Assistance

No – you are **not** eligible for Facilitated Self Assistance*

What tax year are you filing for?

I need to file 2025 taxes – you are eligible to use Facilitated Self Assistance

I need to file taxes for prior years – you are **not** eligible for Facilitated Self Assistance*

Do you have an email address that you can access AND a cell phone on which you can receive text messages? **Both are required to set up your Facilitated Self Assistance account.**

Yes, **to both** – you are eligible for Facilitated Self Assistance

No, **to one or both** – you are **not** eligible for Facilitated Self Assistance*

You must bring the following with you to your Facilitated Self Assistance appointment:

All income documents, including:

W-2's from all jobs you worked

Gambling winnings (W-2G)

Pension income (1099-R)

Unemployment statement (1099-G)

Prior year (2024) AGI (found on line 11 of your 2025 IRS Form 1040 or 1040-SR)

If you do not have your 2024 AGI, please page 2 of this document

Your banking information for direct debit/deposit (bank name, routing number, and account number)

Driver's license or official ID (may be needed if you are also filing a state tax return)

DETERMINE YOUR 2024 ADJUSTED GROSS INCOME (AGI)

Your 2025 adjusted gross income (AGI) must be **less than or equal to \$89,000** to use Facilitated Self Assistance (FSA) to prepare and e-file your tax return.

1. If you do not have any new sources of income and you expect that your income will be similar to what it was for the 2024 tax year, you will find your 2025 AGI on line 11 of your IRS Form 1040 or Form 1040-SR.
2. If your income has changed from last year or if you have new or additional sources of income, please estimate your 2025 AGI as follows:
